

BY-LAW #283

VILLAGE OF AMISK, PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF AMISK IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF PROVINCIAL EMERGENCY 9-1-1 SERVICES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF AMISK.

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Section 54 of the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter 26.1, a Municipality may provide any service or thing that it provides in all or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority.

AND WHEREAS: Pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter 26.1, A Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health & welfare of people and the protection of people & property.

AND WHEREAS: The Council of the Village of Amisk wishes to provide Provincial Emergency 9-1-1 services within the Village and enter into agreements with other agencies and / or municipalities to provide such a service.

NOW THEREFORE: The Council of the Village of Amisk, duly assembled, does enact as follows:

1. The Village of Amisk will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via it's Provincial Emergency 9-1-1 service.
2. The Village of Amisk will enter into an agreement with Wainwright and District Ambulance Service to provide Emergency 9-1-1 "Call Answer, Call Forward" service.
3. The Village of Amisk will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide for Telus to act as a billing and collection agent for the 9-1-1 service provided to the Village.
4. A customer within the Village of Amisk who subscribes to Telus Communication Inc. will be provided with 9-1-1 service and will be required to pay a prescribed fee for the said service.
5. This by-law shall take effect on the date of final passage.

Read a first time this 21 day of November, 1996.

Read a second time this 21 day of November, 1996.

Read a third time and finally passed this 21 day of November, 1996.
